### Military Training

Students in Year 11 and Year 12 have completed their Year 1 and Year 2 military training course that has been taking place at Pak Chong School from Tuesday 29 October until Saturday 9 November. They have undertaken a wide range of training from doing march drills to firing and fire fighting. Well done to everyone for completing the training.

### Secondary Exam Week and Year 11 / Year 12 Practice Examinations

The penultimate week of term, Monday 2 December to Friday 6 December will be the major exam week for secondary students this term. Year 11 / Year 12 may have some examinations in the previous week. Secondary students should now be working hard preparing for these examinations by ensuring that they have learnt and understood the work that they have covered this term and in Year 11's case last year as well, and that they practise past examination questions where they are available.

### Primary


The children in Nursery are gaining more confidence in using some of the play equipment at the playground. They are also learning how to take turns and in helping their friends. KG1 reviewed numbers 1-5 through counting, recognising the numbers in random and watched some numberblocks 1-5. KG2 pupils have been writing letters to the canteen staff to thank them for their hard work and all the food they enjoy eating. It was very nice to see the children all say something special for the letter and deliver it during snack time. Year 1 have been very busy with the new IPC topic about their senses. The pupils enjoyed the senses scavenger hunt. Year 2 pupils have been working hard on assessments this week, so they were very happy to have some time out to enjoy reading books in the library on Wednesday. Some pupils had a good time reading together with friends while others preferred to read to themselves. Year 3 pupils have been designing and carrying out an experiment, testing which materials are most reflective as part of their topic on light in science. Year 5 pupils have been exploring and sorting Antarctic themed vocabulary in English for their new class text 'Ice trap' about Shackleton's expedition. In IPC, they have been identifying the world's biomes and the threats they face from climate change. Year 6 pupils braved the nature trail as our entry point for 'Existing... Endangered...Extinct?' They tallied the number of insects, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, birds, annelids and molluscs that they could find. Unsurprisingly, we did not find any fish!
