Thank you to students, teachers and TAs from KG2 and Year 2 who joined Year 7 in their English Class for a Moo Deng themed Dance Party!



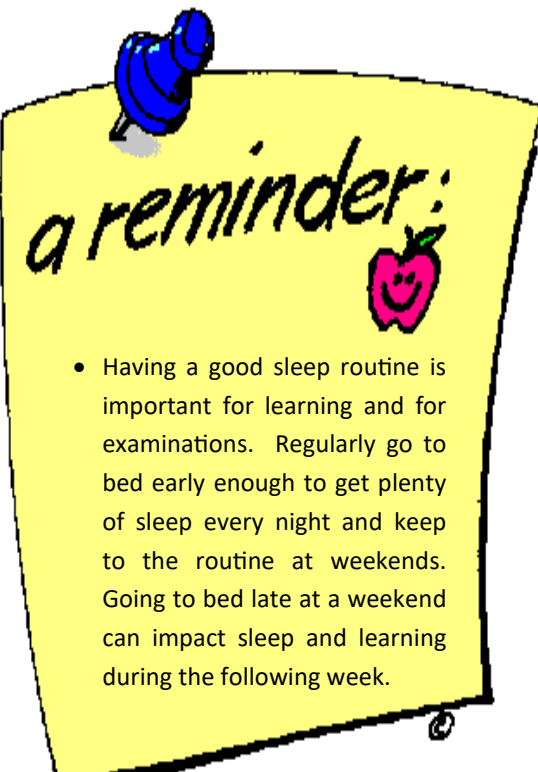
Practice Examinations
