Primary News

Students in EYFS enjoyed participating in their first assembly. The students sat beautifully and enjoyed celebrating their friends' birthdays and achievements. Nursery children started looking at the story of The Colour Monster. The children enjoyed listening to the story and identifying the colours. KG1 pupils have been learning about the number one. They have listened to a number blocks song. They used their hands to show one and made a collage of the number blocks character using a range of different materials. In KG2 the students have been exploring the concept of family and the special people in our lives. They've had a great time sharing family photos with one another. Additionally, the children have been discovering new letters and sounds, and practising their letter printing skills. They collected natural materials for leaf rubbings and used flowers in their counting games, making learning both engaging and fun. Year 1 pupils have been working really hard to learn the new digraph sounds in phonics. They can recognise them, read them and write them independently. Well done Year 1! The pupils have also been recognising numbers as digits and as words. Year 3 have been learning about rocks and their properties, they decided how to test different types of rocks for their buoyancy, permeability and hardness. They made predictions then carried out the experiment, making careful observations. Year 4 have had a fantastic week! In science, they learned to categorise organisms using Venn diagrams. During IPC, they explored fascinating flags from around the world. In English, they published their diary entries, and in mathematics, they revisited their times tables to master number lines. The Year 5 and 6 pupils have been delving deeper into the Impressionist style in their IPC topic, 'They See the World Like This.' Using last week's photography, they created artwork inspired by famous Impressionist artists like Claude Monet, Edgar Degas and Pierre-Auguste Renoir. The students used techniques such as light, colour, and small brushstrokes to bring their photos to life, capturing the essence of Impressionism in their work.
